Learners will plan and create tasty and affordable meals and snacks for all the family. Each week, the group will enjoy the food together and discuss how their ideas can be implemented at home. This is a basic cooking class for people with little or no cooking/kitchen experience.

By the end of the course learners will be able to:

- Develop basic food prep skills
- Develop basic cooking skills
- Use a budget to create tasty family meals for a reasonable price

Learners can progress on to other cookery courses to develop more cookery skills and explore further ideas for affordable and nutritious meals.
